


WALKING TRAIL MARKER LIST



CAPTAIN SPEEDS ROUTE - 2.0 MILES



TRAIL GUIDE

HERITAGE ROUTE - 3.0 Miles
Guides you through early Vicksburg's history, heritage, and the Civil War.

CAPTAIN SPEEDS ROUTE - 2.0 Miles
Guides you through Vicksburg's first neighborhood. The trail can be added to the Heritage Route or done separately.

COURT HOUSE ROUTE - 2.2 Miles
Start at the Trailhead and go straight up one of Vicksburg's hills to the Old Court House Museum and then continue along the Heritage Route (Green).

SPRINGFIELD ROUTE - 1.5 Miles
Start at the Trailhead following the Heritage Route (Green) through the oldest parts of Vicksburg. At Cherry Street continue straight on Grove Street (Purple) rejoining the Heritage Route (Green) to finish at the Art Park.

DOWNTOWN ROUTE - 1.8 Miles
Start at the Trailhead leaving the Heritage Route (Green) at Monroe Street and continuing up the hill to Cherry Street to rejoin and follow the Heritage Route (Green) to the Art Park.

Note: ALL TRAIL ROUTES start at the Trailhead and end at Catfish Row Art Park except the Captain Speeds Route.
